In 2010, the Kraft Heinz Dover plant sponsored a KaBOOM! playground that was built right here in Central Delaware.

Kraft Heinz Dover is the third-largest employer in the area. The plant's estimated contribution to the local economy in

payroll, utilities, taxes, and local goods and services totals approximately \$35 million annually.

Kraft Heinz Dover is divided into three operations: Desserts, Beverages and Bread Network. Located at 1250 West North Street in Dover, the facilities are housed under 1 million square feet of roof on 117 acres. Kraft Heinz Dover opened as a General Foods factory in 1964 through the merging of four plants: Franklin Baker plant of N.J., Jell-O plant of N.Y., Walter Baker plant of Mass. and Minute plant of Mass..

In 1969, they announced that the Dover plant would temporarily produce Kool-Aid, which it did until 1987, and then later brought Kool-Aid back to Dover in 1992. By 1976, the Dover factory ran its 500th million case of Jell-O Gelatin. In 1991, the Dover plant continued to expand its product line

by producing Minute Microwave, which was a variety of shelf stable rice and pasta products.

In February of 2009, Kraft Heinz Dover installed two Crystal Light multi-serve lines and added 10.5 million pounds of Canadian volume to its dry packaged desserts and Shake 'N Bake lines. Just over a year later, the plant installed a new high-speed coconut line that replaced four aging coconut lines.

On Jan. 2, 2017, the plant began making bread in a new state-of-the-art bakery.

"We are really excited to be baking bread in Dover," Dover Plant Materials Manager Alex Guardi stated. "The bakery will make significant use of automation."

The bakery alone is 50,000 square feet and has brought over 25 new jobs to Dover.

Kraft Heinz is now the fifth-largest food and beverage company in the world. Kraft Heinz Dover is doing wonderful, amazing things for Kent County. We, at the CDCC, are excited to see what's to come!

It's "Politics NOT as Usual" for the LCD Class of 2017 Government & Politics Day!

With politics and government in our National headlines these days, it was a welcome relief and honor for the LCD Class of 2017 to visit our State Capital and learn firsthand the history of government of our great state of Delaware, but also to see our government and politics in action!

The day started with a wonderful presentation/discussion by Secretary of State Jeffrey Bullock on the State Initiatives for 2017, then, proceeded to a panel discussion on How Government Works with Representative Daniel Short, Representative Quinn Johnson, and Scott Kidner of C.S. Kidner & Associates.

From there, the class enjoyed a wonderful and informative tour of Legislative Hall by Sarah Zimmerman, First State Heritage Park.

They learned about the history of the "First State"- such as the first Governors of the State went by the title, "President", that the "Blue Hens" were a breed of chickens/hens that were owned by Captain Caldwell of the 2nd Company of patriot fighters from Kent County, Delaware in the Revolutionary War. He and his company used these chickens/hens in cock fights, a popular amusement at the time, and they gained a reputation for their ferocity and fighting success thereby taking the name as "The Fighting Blue Hens" from Delaware!

Next, the class was presented with 2 Hot Topic Round Table Discussions:

1.) Minimum Wage - A discussion about the current proposed Bill before the legislature regarding raising the minimum wage in DE from

the current \$8.25/hr. to \$10.25/hr. by 2020. Presenters for this topic were Representative Trey Paradee and Janie Libby, the Chair of the Chamber Board of Directors.

2.) Gas Tax Increase - A discussion about a current proposal in the House about raising the gas tax from 0.23/gallon to potentially 0.37/gallon. Presenting for this topic: Mike Riemann, Becker Morgan, President of the Civil Engineering Association and Rob Book, Vice President of Membership Services, Delaware Electric Cooperative.

The final part of the day the LCD Class of 2017 itself took part in a "Mock City Council Meeting" with assigned roles and a scenario to petition for annexation before the City Council. Mayor Robin Christiansen and Councilman Bill Hare were on hand to help with the proceedings.

The take-aways from this memorable day were:

- 1.) Learned a great deal about the History of Delaware
 - 2.) Got a glimpse into how Delaware State Government works
 - 3.) Saw articulate arguments expressed on both sides of various issues
 - And, perhaps most surprising and enlightening, we saw:
 - 1.) Differing opinions and positions argued and articulated in a respectful way
 - 2.) Opponents and Colleagues alike LISTENING & RESPECTING each other
 - 3.) Colleagues from different sides of the aisle actually LIKING each other
 - 4.) Joking, Camaraderie and FRIENDSHIP within the parties!
- Perhaps, Washington DC. Could take a lesson from Delaware?

Q: When did you begin working for this business and what is your role?

Dr. Dina Vendetti began working at St. John's in July of 2000. She was called here to begin the elementary school program. She serves as the principal and also teaches in their Middle School: Religion, Literature, and Art History.

St. John's Lutheran Church is approaching its 100th Anniversary in the next few years. St. John's Early Learning Center began operation in 1989 on Lotus St. (same property as the church) – the preschool works with students ages 2 – 4 in both a preschool and day care setting. In 2000, the school began its elementary program on Walker Road. They started with about 20 Pre K and Kindergarten kids and began adding grade levels as these students progressed through the program. Eventually, the middle school was added. Today, they operate a program on Walker Rd. that goes from Kindergarten through 8th grade.

St. John's offers a quality Christian education in a traditional setting, experiences of service and involvement in the community, and intentional leadership training. Their academic program is executed by a well-trained staff who works diligently to involve the whole family in the education of their children. In addition to the regular academic subjects like math, literature/reading, language art, social studies, and science, the students also have

opportunities each week to participate in "special" classes like music, physical education, music, Chinese, and library skills. St. John's School also offers extended care for our students – before school from 7 – 8:30 am and 3 – 5:30 pm.

"I believe that in the future St. John's will continue to grow as a positive vital force in our community," Dr. Vendetti expressed. "As we continue to serve the community by delivering a high quality educational experience, offer opportunities for our students to serve the community, and graduate people who are excellent citizens and effective servant leaders, we will become the private school of choice in our area."

Dr. Vendetti considers the membership in the Central Delaware Chamber of Commerce to be a real blessing to St. John's School. Joining the Chamber in 2003 opened many doors for the school. Shortly after joining, Dr. Vendetti was afforded the opportunity of participating in Leadership Central Delaware (Class of 2004). "As a newcomer to this area, it was immensely helpful to me to learn about Kent County and to meet the people who are the leaders in this area." Dr. Vendetti stated. "It also gave me a chance to develop relationships with the wide variety of professionals that were in my class." The education and the networking opportunities through that one experience truly helped to
